



Dressing-up Clothes Policy

- Dressing-up clothes will be available for children to access during session times.
- Resources are selected to be non-discriminatory, promoting positive images of people of all races, cultures and capabilities, avoiding racial and gender stereotyping.
- All dressing-up and role-play resources are available to all children, Peach Tree Pre-school does not advocate discriminatory practice.
- Children are encouraged to continue their role-play across all areas of the pre-school, both inside and out, however, to minimise risks, children will be actively discouraged from wearing dressing-up shoes and long dressing-up items when playing outside. In such circumstances, safety reasons will be illustrated to the children and alternatives will be discussed and suggested.
- Long dressing-up items are defined as long items of clothing/material that could present a trip hazard or be caught in moving mechanisms.
